





### Nephrology Advice Request is now live!

Ten percent of Albertan adults struggle with chronic kidney disease (CKD). Early identification and management can reduce progression and cardiovascular risk. However, testing for CKD should not be universal but should be targeted for individuals at increased risk of developing CKD.

Within eReferral, an advice request can be used when physicians are unsure if a referral would be appropriate, when considerations of care are uncertain, or when any other specialty specific information is uncertain and advice is required.

Advice requests support community centred care, reduce unnecessary referrals and better support patients while they are waiting to be seen.

eReferral provides secure communication between primary care physicians and Alberta nephrologists through Alberta Netcare. Your question will be responded to within 5 days. Both referring and advising physicians may bill through AMA eConsult codes.

- Acute kidney injury
- Chronic kidney disease (CKD)
- Electrolyte abnormalities
- Hematuria microscopic (blood in urine)
- Proteinuria (abnormal protein in urine)
- Kidney stones
- General nephrology
