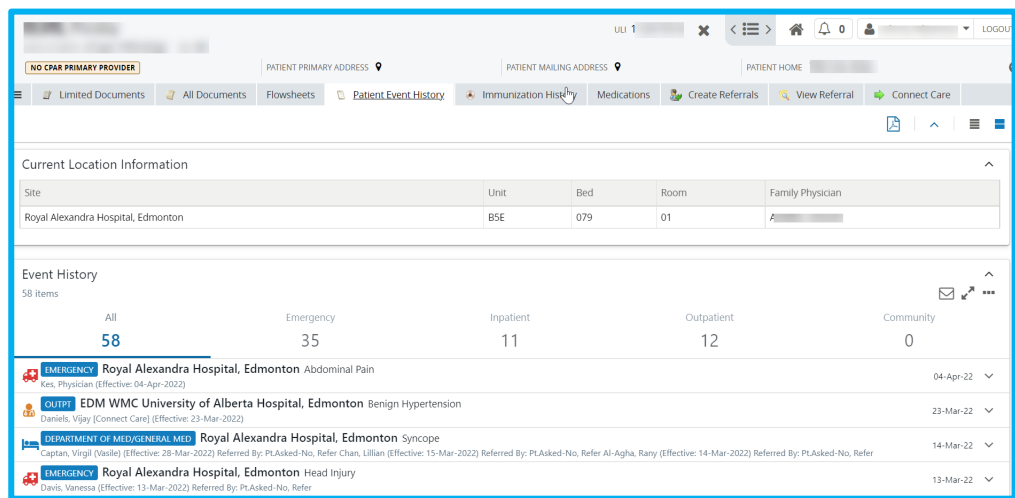

What's New

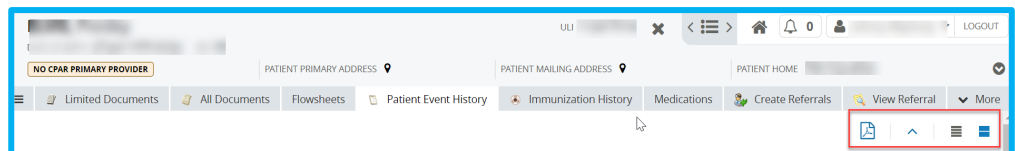
Patient Event History upgraded with new functionalities

Description: **Patient Event History has been enhanced to display patient information in a modernized, easier to read layout, and to allow users to easily change how patient event information is displayed.**

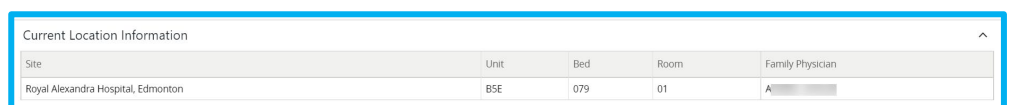
Details: "Patient Event History" features a new, modern layout with good resolution on various screen sizes and settings. The new layout is more dynamic, allowing users to filter events and expand and collapse sections to view more or less information. These components include the Control Bar, Current Location Information Panel, and Event History Panel with a filter.



Control Bar: The Control Bar enables users to take actions applicable to the current Event History view, such as to save the Event History as a PDF, expand or collapse the Event History Panels, and modify the view of the Event History screen.



Current Location Information Panel: The Current Location Information shows if a patient is admitted or not. If the patient is currently admitted, their Site, Unit, Bed, Room, and Family Physician information will be displayed.



Event History Panel:

The Event History Panel contains the Event History Control Bar, the Case Type Filters, and the patient events and associated information.

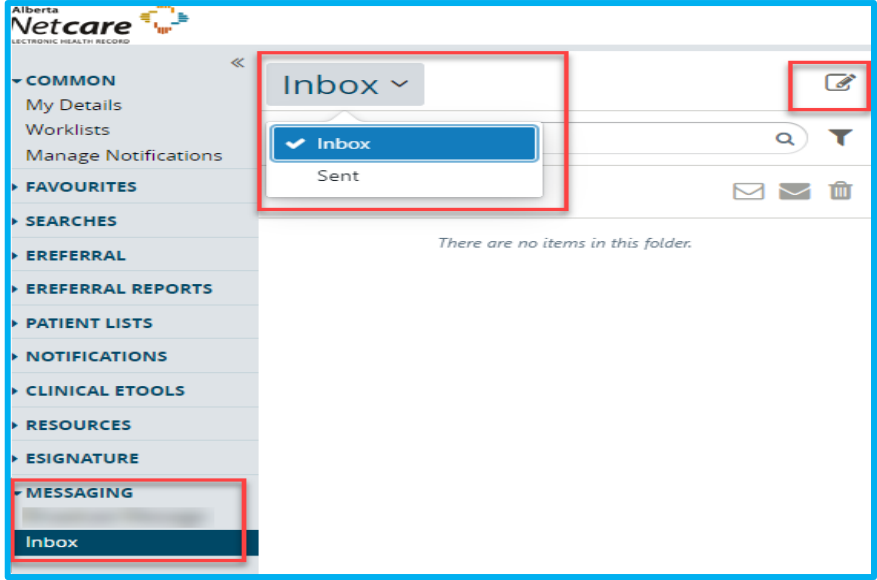

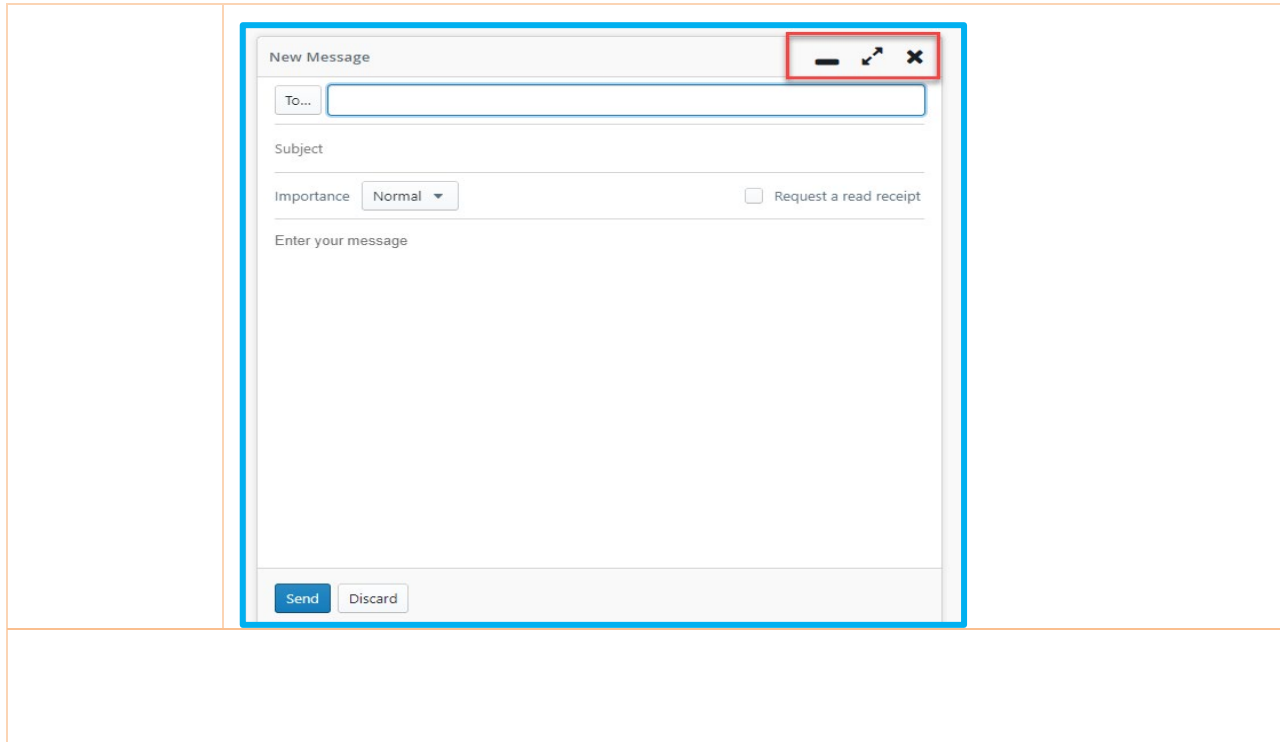

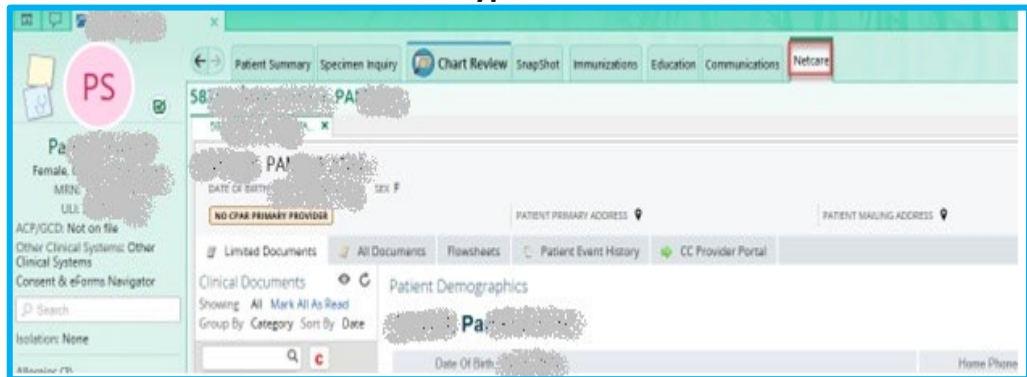
What's Changed
