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eReferral Consult Request Facilities

Five New Virtual Facilities added to eReferral Consult Request

Description:	Five (5) new virtual facilities have been added to eReferral Consult Request. Consult Requests are non-urgent requests for an in-person appointment with a specialist.
Details:	<p>OBS-GYN – Gynecology: Gynecology has added five (5) new CAT facilities, with forty (40) Reasons for Referral.</p> <p>Added facilities are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Calgary Gynecology CAT • Central Gynecology CAT • Edmonton Gynecology CAT • North Gynecology CAT • South Gynecology CAT <p>The Reasons for Referral (RFR) are:</p> <p>New RFRs</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cervical lesion suspected benign • Cervical lesion suspected malignant • Vesico-urethral fistula • Mesh complications (from previous prolapse repair or incontinence repair) • Abnormal uterine bleeding (AUB) • Amenorrhea • Adenomyosis • Dysmenorrhea • Pain in the pelvis (gynecological cause suspected) • Post menopausal bleeding • Uterine fibroid • Uterine polyp • Adnexal mass • Management of primary ovarian insufficiency (premature ovarian failure) • Polycystic ovarian syndrome (PCOS) • Cancer risk reducing gynecological surgery • Contraception • Infertility • Recurrent pregnancy loss • Vaginitis

eReferral Modifications

Deactivation of Facility and “Urology Issues” Advice Request RFR

Description:	Deactivation of "Urology - Calgary Zone" facility, and one "Urology issue" Advice Request reason for referral.
Details:	At the request of the specialty, the reason for referral "Urology Issue" will be deactivated, as well as the Urology – Calgary Zone facility. Note: The specialty and RFR are not being deactivated, just the one facility

Deactivation of Nephrology – Central Zone Facility and all associated RFRs

Description:	Deactivation of Nephrology facility and seven reasons for referral.
Details:	Nephrology – Central Zone facility has been deactivated from eReferral Advice Request, with the seven (7) reasons for referral. The deactivated Reasons for Referral (RFR) are: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Acute kidney injury 2. Chronic kidney disease 3. Kidney stone chronic (non-obstructing) 4. Electrolyte abnormalities 5. Hematuria microscopic (greater than 3 rbc/hpf) 6. Nephrology issue 7. Proteinuria NOTE: Kidney stone chronic and Hematuria microscopic are also offered by Urology for CONSULT. The Consult request RFR is available.
