Improving Continuity of Care and Heath Outcomes

Community Information Integration (CII) and the Central Patient Attachment Registry (CPAR) initiatives work together to enhance communication between health care providers and Alberta Netcare.

- Cll enables providers to seamlessly share patient information with Alberta Netcare, ensuring that all members of a patient's care team have access to critical health data.
- CPAR helps identify and confirm the relationships between patients and their primary care providers, ensuring that care decisions are informed by accurate provider-patient relationships.

Real-time Data Transition for Pharmacies

The ACP's Real-Time Integration (RTI) standard of practice will take effect on February 1, 2025. Existing pharmacies are required to have RTI fully implemented by **July 2026**.

Please note that the PIA approval process for RTI can take 8 to 12 months to complete. If your pharmacy has not yet begun the RTI implementation process, now is the time to start! For more information, contact eHealth Services.

RSA SecurID Tokens

To log into ANP remotely via the Citrix Workspace application, you need to complete 2-factor authentication using your user ID and an RSA SecurID token. You can use the default software (soft) token or request a hardware (hard) token by exception. If your token expires or becomes disabled, please contact your facility's Authorized Approver to request reactivation. Learn more.

ANP Account Sunset Dates

ANP user accounts have an annual sunset date that the Netcare Authorized Approver is notified of in advance and is able to extend via AHS IAM. Please review the Access Certification Fact Sheet.
